 - ** Any foreigner who has stayed in Korea for over six months is subject to mandatory subscription to National Health Insurance Service
- 6. Bank Statement with the account balance of USD10,000 or above
 - * If the applicant is not the account holder, please submit a proof of relationship.
- 7. A Korean sponsorship letter(Some of countries don't need this document) * If necessary, additional documents may be required & all documents can't be returned.
