



# 2019 MSD MIDSUMMER'S DREAM AT DUKSUNG

*This special program is designed for international students who are willing to share their culture with other participants while learning Korean language and its culture. MSD will be sponsored by Duksung Women's University in order to celebrate the 100th year of its foundation. Duksung Women's University is located in the capital, Seoul, of Korea and staying at Duksung will give you an opportunity to explore the dynamic city and its culture.*



## 1 Time Period

*July 1-19, 2019 [3 weeks] / Orientation on June 26 & 28*

- Accommodation will be available from July 1<sup>st</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> FREE of CHARGE. (complimentary breakfast included)
- Free Airport Pick up will be arranged on June 26<sup>th</sup> (Wed) & 28<sup>th</sup> (Fri) at 13:00.
- Free Airport Drop off will be arranged on July 20<sup>th</sup> (Sat) at 13:00 from the dormitory.
- You must arrange your own transportation from/to the airport besides the arranged pick up/drop off time.

## 2 Eligibility

- Students currently enrolled in a college/university.
- Korean proficiency is not required. Korean language courses will be conducted in two levels, beginner and intermediate. (DUKSUNG Buddies are going to support participants during the program.)

## 3 VISA

- Applicants must apply for a short-term study visa(D-2-8) to their Korean Embassy or Consulate Office.
- We encourage applicants to apply for the visa as soon as they receive a letter of admission.

## 4 Fees and Scholarships

- Program Fee : FREE (including tuition, accommodation, and some meals)
- Accommodation will be provided only during the program.
- Other Costs (paid by participant) :
  - Application fee : KRW 120,000(non-refundable)
  - Roundtrip Airfare
  - Visa(D-2-8) issuance fee
  - Meals when it is not provided (lunch & dinner on weekdays and weekends)
  - You must provide your own international health insurance from your home country.
  - Fees for Optional Activities, Travel expenses and other living costs
